in pathal modification to the Ministry of Finance Office Memorandum FMO 19036/1/2000-E.IV daied 21st March, 2000, and in order to simplify the pronudure for processing of foreign thur/deputation proposals where invitation is received directly by the officers of OOI based on their expertise to a particular field, the following is laid down for compliance by all concerned :-

- (i) invitation to participate in workshop/confirmee/supther/study impropresentation of papers of abroad is received directly by the officers by minte, by vitue of his/her expertise in a particular field, such visits will be tranted as in personal capacity for which the officer would have to proceed on leave after obtaining approval of the computent authority.
- \*(11) The visits of the above nature are to be allowed only if 100% funding support is provided by the organizers. The Miniarios/Departments may consider such proposals at their level in the officers of the level of Joint Spergary and below, in consultation with the Minister and the Financial Adviser concorned. Necessary elegrances viz. political elegrance from MEA and FCRA elegrance from MHA. sylierever required, may invariably be obtained for such visits.
  - Invitations/proposals of the above kind in the officers of the level of Additional (iii) Secretary and above will continue to be referred to the Barconing Committee of Secretaries for cunsideration.
  - Invitations for participation in training/workshops/seminars/conferences/as a (IV) 'Resource person', organized by external agencles will continue to be governed by Instructions of Department of Economic Affairs, which is the nodal department in Government of India dealing with external aid, issued vide DO letter No. 12(51)/2001-BBC(Coord) dated 10th July, 2001.

(v) Remuneration/honorarium/fees, if any, received by the officer during such visits will be governed by SR-11 and SR-12 (FR-SR- Part-1) and GOI orders printed there-under.
