## FRI holds training programme on "Conservation and Management of Coastal Ecosystems"

**DEHRADUN, JAN 8 (HTNS)** Forest Research Institute is organizing a training programme for commandants of Indian Coast Guard from January 8 to 12. The topic of training is "Conservation and Management of Coastal Ecosystems". The five days training programme aims to sensitize the officers

of coast guard towards the marine ecosystems and marine protected areas and their management in India.

The interactions and brainstorming sessions with coast guard commandants would be helpful in sensitizing them about important flora and fauna of the coastal areas which need to be protected for sustaining biodiversity and habitat protection of endangered wildlife. Eminent faculties from various institutes like Indian Institute of Remote Sensing, Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy, National Institute of Hydrology, Roorkee, TRAFFIC office, New Delhi, Indian Meteorological Dept,

## एफआरआई में कोस्टल कंजर्वेशन पर मंथन

## कोस्टगार्ड को समुद्री सुरक्षा की जानकारी
