Madam,

Kindly refer to the above cited letter wherein it was requested that the forestry research, education and extension should be treated at par for assessment under FCS and the scientists engaged in education, publicity etc. should be evaluated for rendering academic services and appropriately equated to research publications.

A committee was constituted under the Chairmanship of DDG (Education), ICFRE to examine the proposal. After examining the DoPT guidelines issued vide O.M. No. AB-14017/37/2008-Estt (RR) dated 10th September, 2010, it was observed that the research component is an essential dimension for considering the promotion of the scientists. However, the committee observed that the Research, Education and Extension are in-built components of S&T work functions as mentioned in the DoPT O.M.

As such, the cumulative work report consisting of the self assessment by the officer reported upon and (b) assessment by the reporting officer and reviewing officer should be very comprehensive, highlighting all the S&T outputs of the eligible scientists. Needless to say that the S & T outputs would include all aspects of research, education and extension. This comprehensive report will be presented before the internal screening committee and the Assessment Board for assessing the promotion of the Scientists.

It is therefore, stated that the self assessment of scientists/Director's report should capture all the contributions to the S&T functions given in DoPT O.M. dated 10th September, 2010 and furnished to the ICFRE (Hq) for assessment of the scientists including the assessment due as on 01st July 2018. The reports already furnished for assessment due on 01st July, 2018 may also be revised incorporating all the S&T indicators, if not already done. It is further requested that the essentiality of research component for promotions under MFCS as per the DoPT O.M. may be brought to the notice of all scientists.

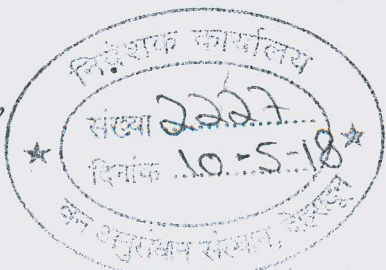
