Minimum requirement for eligibility:-

- 1. The chemist should hold valid licenses in specified forms for various categories of allopathic drugs issued by the Drug Control Authority of the Statef under the provision of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.
- 2. No conviction certificate from the State Drug Controller stating that no case is pending against the firm under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act & the rules made thereunder as well as under Drugs Price Control order issued from time to time.
- 3. The turnover of the bidder (Chemist) should be at least Rs.20 Lakh only (Rs. Twenty Lakhs only) in the last three financial years. The bidder must submit the documentary evidence like Profit & Loss A/c, audited Balance Sheet in support of their claim.
- 4. Affidavit to the effect that the chemist shop/establishment is situated within 10kilometers distanced by shortest motorable route from the New Forest Hospital.
- 5. GST registration and clearance certificate for the last three years from the concerned STO (Sales Tax Officer).
- 6. A copy of PAN allotted to the firm.

Enquiries will be entertained in the pre-bid conference only. Director, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun reserves the right to reject all/any application received from the chemists without assigning any reason.

SECTION-I

Instruction to Bidders

1. SCOPE OF WORK

The empanelled chemists will supply the medicines/drugs at the agreed discount in the stipulated time on the basis of the Indents/authority slip issued by the New Forest Hospital.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 The chemist must hold valid licenses as on the date of Bid opening in specified forms (For, 20, 20-B, 21, 21-B & 21-C) for various categories of allopathic drugs issued by the Drug Control Authority of the State under the provision of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940. The successful Bidder will further ensure that their licenses remain valid till the end of the contract period.
- 2.2 The chemist must not have been convicted by the State drugs authorities and no case should be pending under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Rules.
- 2.3 The annual turnover of the bidder should be as per Annexure-I during the last three financial years. The Chemist shop/establishment should be situated within 10 kilometers distance by shortest motorable route from the New Forest Hospital.
- 2.4 GST clearance certificate should be available with the bidder.

3. COST OF BIDDING

The prospective bidders shall bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of their bid. The FRI in no case will be responsible or liable for these costs regardless of conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4. PRE BID MEETING

- 4.1 A pre-bid meeting open to all prospective bidders will be held as per Bidding Schedule in the office of the Purchase Officer, Forest Research Institute, New Forest, Dehradun wherein the prospective bidders will have an opportunity to obtain clarifications regarding work and tender conditions.
- 4.2 The prospective bidders are free to ask for any additional information and clarifications concerning the work either in writing or orally. The clarifications given will be common and applicable to all bidders.

4 BIDDING PROCEDURE, SIGNING AND SEALINGS OF BIDS

5.1 The bidder must submit his Bid in two sealed envelopes as mentioned below:

Envelops No. 1:- Called "Technical Bid Envelope" containing:-

(A) Earnest Money

The bidder are required to submit a Demand Draft of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakhs only) in the name of "The Director, FRI" payable at Dehradun as Earnest Money. The Demand Draft must be issued by a Scheduled Bank.

(B) Documents establishing Bidders eligibility (Technical Bid)

The following documents should be submitted along with the Technical Bid in the sequence mentioned below. Each page will be duly signed and serially numbered. Corrections or overwriting duly attested.

- a) Photocopy of the demand draft by which earnest money has been submitted.
- b) Proof of deposit of Rs. 1770/- as Tender cost.
- c) Duly attested copies of valid licenses held by the bidder as on the date of Bid opening in specified forms (Form 20, 20-B, 21, 21-B & 21-C) for various categories of allopathic drugs issued by the Drug Control Authority of the State under the provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940. The successful Bidder will ensure that their licenses remain valid till the end of the contract period.
- d) Declaration of bidder as per Annexure-C.
- e) Copy of the Partnership Deed if the bidder is a Partnership concern.
- f) GST clearance certificate.
- g) Letter of Authority as per Annexure-D.
- h) No conviction certificate from State Drugs Controller that no case is pending against the firm under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Rules made there under as well as under the Drugs Price Control order issued from time to time.
- i) Copies of the balance sheets for the last three financial years to establish the turnover of the bidder.
- j) Proof of availability of bar code scanning facilities with the bidder.

Envelope No. 2: Called "Commercial Bid Envelope" which shall contain:

Duly filled prescribed Bid form (Price Bid as per Annexure B) containing the discount offered NB: The discount offered shall not be less than 29.6% in any case.

5.2

- a) The Bid is liable to be rejected, if the required information/documents have not been furnished as asked for in Clause 5.1 (B)
- b) Individual signing the Bid and other documents must specify whether he signs as:
- i. A sole proprietor of the firm, or constituted attorney of such proprietor.
- ii. A partner of the firm, if it is a partnership firm and in this case he must have a clear legal authority to sign, answer and admit to refer disputes to arbitration.

Note:

- 1. In case of (ii) above a copy of the Partnership Deed, General Power of Attorney, duly attested by a notary public and an affidavit to the effect that all the partners admit execution of the partnership and the General Power of Attorney to be furnished.
- 2. In case of partnership firm, where no authority to refer disputes concerning the business or the partnership has been conferred on any such partner, the Bid and all other related documents must be signed by every partner of the firm.
- 3. A person signing the Bid form or any documents forming part of the bid on behalf of another shall be deemed under warranty that he has authority to bind with his acts such other person. If on enquiry, it

appears that the person so signing has no authority to do so, the FRI without prejudice to other Civil and Criminal remedies can cancel the contract and hold the signatory responsible for all costs and conveyances arising there from.

5.3 Both the Technical Bid and Commercial Bid Envelopes shall be sealed separately and shall clearly indicate "Envelope No. 1-Technical Bid" and "Envelope No. 2- Commercial Bid" respectively. Both the sealed envelopes shall be kept in the third envelope and shall be addressed to the Purchase Officer, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

Please write the Tender Notice No. on each Envelope and seal all the Envelopes.

5.4 PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

The Bids shall be valid for acceptance for 90days after the date of Bid opening prescribed by the FRI and shall be further extendable by another 30days at the request of FRI.

5.5 PERIOD OF CONTRACT

The period of the contract shall be for a period of two years from the date of the signing of contract. However, strictly on the basis of the satisfactory services it is liable to be extended for a period of one more year at the sole discretion of Director, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun on the same terms and conditions.

5.6 RIGHTS TO ACCEPT/REJECT ANY BID

The Director, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun reserve the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for the FRI action.

The Director, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun doesn't pledge himself to accept the highest discount offering Bid or any Bid and reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the Bid and Bidder shall supply the medicines at the rates quoted.

5.7 PERFORMANCE SECURITY GUARANTEE

The successful bidder will have to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs.2,00,000.00 (Rs. Two Lakhs Only) either in the form of Bank Guarantee valid for 30 months (as per format at Annexure-A) issued by the Scheduled Bank or through Demand Draft payable to "Director, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun" No claim shall be made against Director, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun in respect of interest if any due on the Performance Security.

The Performance Bank Guarantee should remain valid upto six months beyond the validity of the contract.

5.8 CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRACTICES

- (i) The FRI requires that the Bidder under this bid observes the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts.
- (ii) In pursuance of this policy, the terms are set forth as follows:

- a) "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of the public official in the procurement process or in contract execution; and
- b) "fraudulent practice" means misrepresentation of facts in order to influence the procurement process or execution of a contract to the detriment of the FRI, and includes collusive practice among bidder (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the FRI of the benefits of the free and open competition.
- (iii) The FRI will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.
- (iv) The FRI will declare a firm eligible, either indefinitely or for a specified period of time, for award of the contract if at any time it determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.

5.9 FORFEITURE

The Earnest Money may be forfeited if a Bidder withdraws its tender during the period of bid validity or in case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails:

- i. To sign the contract in accordance with the terms and conditions, and
- ii. To furnish Performance Security as specified in the terms and conditions.

5 SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- (i) The Bidders will submit the Bid documents at the office of the Purchase Officer, Forest Research Institute, Dehradun by the time and date as stipulated in the Bidding Schedule. The Bids received after this date will not be entertained. The postal delays will also not be condoned.
- (ii) Any conditional Bid will not be accepted.

6 PRICING

The bidder should quote uniform discount on retail price printed on strip/Bottle/Unit packed in percentage terms in respect of all items of supplies to be made under the Contract. It should be noted that liability to pay any GST/Levy/Cess/Octroi etc. leviable under the law would be that of the supplier. FRI will pay the labeled MRP minus local taxes less tendered discount thereon. The quoted offer shall remain valid for the entire duration of the contract.

INSPECTION FO BIDDERS PREMISES

If the Technical Bid on the basis of the documents mentioned in this section appears to be fulfilling the eligibility conditions the Bidders' premises will be inspected by a team of officers for (a) physical verification of site and distance, (b) verification of original documents (c) availability of proper cold-chain which would be refrigerator and power back up system and (d) presence of retail outlet (e) assess availability of stock of medicines both physical and financial etc. before opening the Commercial Bid. In case, the team is not satisfied with the veracity of the claims of the bidder the Commercial Bid will not be opened.

7 OPENING OF BIDS

Tenders shall be opened at the office of the Purchase Officer, Forest Research Institute, New Forest, Dehradun. One representative of the Bidder having the authority letter (Annexure-D) can attend the Bid opening event. The Technical Bid envelopes are to be opened in the first instance at the time and date stipulated in the Bidding Schedule. Thereafter in the second stage the Commercial Bid envelope shall be opened only of the acceptable offers based on the Technical Bids.

8 NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF BID

The Purchase Officer, Forest Research Institute, New Forest, Dehradun. will communicate acceptance of the Bid by a letter.

9 MISCELLANEOUS

- 9.2 The Director, Forest Research Institute, New Forest, Dehradun reserves the right to enter into parallel contracts simultaneously or at any time during the period of this contract, with one or more chemists.
- 9.3 Appointed chemist will as and when required attend the meeting fixed by the Local Advisory Committee in the New Forest Hospital.
- 9.4 Those chemists in whose cases the FRI has terminated their contract on the basis of substitution of medicines, over charging in the bill, misbehavior with FRI beneficiaries/Officers etc. will not be eligible for participating in the Tender (Affidavit to be submitted).
- 9.5 The successful Bidder's Earnest Money will be discharged upon the Bidder executing the Contract and furnishing the Performance Security. Unsuccessful Bidder's Earnest Money will be discharged/returned within 30days after the expiration of the period of tender offer validity prescribed by the FRI.

Section - II

Conditions of Contract

1. COLLECTION OF INDENT FOR SUPPLY

The Authorized Chemist or his representative should collect local Purchase Indent on the basis of which supplies are to be made, from the New Forest Hospital, FRI, Dehradun at the closing hours of New Forest Hospital on every working day. The indent will also be supplied on line through the interest.

2. DELIVERY OF SUPPLIES

The delivery of the supplies in full will be made on the next working day by 8.30 a.m or at the opening hours of New Forest Hospital, whichever is later, at the premises of the New Forest Hospital indenting the supplies or in case of emergency at the residence of the patients as directed by Officer I/c of the New Forest Hospital.

3. NON SUBSTITUTION

In Case of Indent for specific brand of medicines, the brand shall not be substituted.

4. 4.1 PACKEDD SUPPLIED

Supplies are required to be made in original packing of manufacturing. The packing should approximately be nearest to the total quantity demanded of any particular medicine/drug on any particular day.

4.2 INDIVIDUAL PACKETS

The local chemist shall put all medicines indented for one patient in one packet and write the name and the quantity of medicines on the packed of the patient.

5. AUTHORITY SLIP

In case an Authorized Medical Attendant of the New Forest Hospital concerned gives any 'By Hand' Authority Slip to a beneficiary, the medicines will be supplied immediately to the beneficiary for a period as mentioned in the slip or for 7days, whichever is less.

6. LIFE FPERIOD OF MEDICINES SUPPLIED

Every medicine has its own shelf – life period mentioned on the label of medicine. The shelf life of medicines supplied should not have passed more than half of its shelf life at the time of supply.

7. 7.1 ONLINE CONNECTIVITY WITH DISPENSARY

The Local chemist shall be provided with the indent online by the New Forest Hospital. The chemist will therefore have to ensure connectivity with the FRI computer network. Copies of the indent shall be printed by the local chemist on plain computer stationery as per specifications prescribed by FRI. Billing will have to be online. The chemist must also have facilities for bar-code scanning.

7.2 PRESENTATION OF BILLS:

- i. The Authorized chemist shall present the bill to New Forest Hospital for the supplies made during each fortnight (1 to 15 & 16 to 30/31) within ten days of closing of each respective fortnight. The bill should clearly indicate the details of the supplies made each day such as name of the item, name of manufacturer, batch No., date of manufacture & expiry date, prescription slip No. with date, rate discount as per contract etc. and any other information required by the FRI.
- ii. The bill shall be supported by the original indent along with the certificate from the Officer in-charge of New Forest Hospital under his/her signature, with date, seal of the office for receipt of the items indented.

In complete bills not accompanied by any of the particulars mentioned in (i) above will not be entertained.

8. PERIOD UPTO WHICH SUPPLY ORDERS WILL BE PLACED

Supply orders will be placed against the contract upto the last date of contract. Orders received even on the closing date should be honored in accordance with the terms of contract even though the last date of the contract may have expired on the date of supply of medicines.

9. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

The amount of Performance Security shall be liable to be forfeited if the medicines supplied by the authorized Chemist against the indents placed on them in pursuance of this contract are subsequently found as having been stolen from anywhere or are not conforming to quality. The Performance Security is also liable to be forfeited if the authorized chemist:

- i. Fails to adhere to the terms of the Contract or
- ii. Supplies any sub-standard, spurious drugs or the substitute medicines.
- iii. Delays supplies.
- iv.Over charges

The Chemist should not stop the supplies of the medicines/drugs without giving 30days notice.

10. DEDUCTIONS FOR DELAY/DEFADULT

- 10.1 In case of indent for specific brand of medicines, the same shall not be substituted. If any such case is noticed during subsequent scrutiny after or before the payment, then supplier will be penalized for Rs.1000 + cost of the specific brand of medicines for each such default.
- 10.2 The delivery of supplies in full will be made on the next working day by 8.30a.m or at the opening hours of New Forest Hospital, whichever is later, at the premises of the New Forest Hospital indenting the supplies or in case of emergency at the residence of the patients as directed by Officer I/c of New Forest Hospital. In the event of non-supply of indented medicines in time as aforesaid Rs. 500/- will be deducted from the bill of the Chemists for each day or part thereof of delay in respect of each item.

11. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

The FRI may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the bidder terminate the Contract in whole or part:

- a) If the bidder fails to provide any or all of the services within the period(s) specified in the Contract.
- b) If the bidder fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract.
- c) If the bidder, in the judgment of the FRI has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Contract.

12. RESERVATION OF RIGHT FOR APPOINTMENT OF MORE CHEMISTS FOR NEW FOREST HOSPITAL

The Director, FRI, Dehradun reserves the right to appoint any number of Authorized Chemists for New Forest Hospital. The Director, FRI, Dehradun also reserves the right to decide which chemist shall normally serve with New Forest Hospital if the same discount offered by more than one bidder. Without prejudice to the right, emergency purchases can be preferred from any of the empanelled chemist irrespective of such allotment of New Forest Hospital to each Authorized Chemist for purchase of normal supplies.

SUPPLY OF MEDICINES

- 13.1 Sufficient stock of standard quality of medicines at all times will have to be maintained by the chemist, to avoid inconvenience to the ICFREPHS beneficiaries.
- 13.2 In case of failure or refusal on chemist's part to supply the medicines to the purchaser/beneficiaries within the time as provided in clause 12 hereunder, the contract is liable to be terminated/cancelled at chemist's risk and cost. Any extra cost involved in arranging supply from alternative source will be recovered from the chemist. It is in addition and without prejudice to the deduction in clauses 12 & 13 hereunder.
- 13.3 The chemist will indicate batch number, name of manufacturer, date of expiry in the indents at the time of supplying the medicines/drugs to New Forest Hospital.
- 13.4 (a) The medicines/drugs to be supplied will be of standard quality. In case it is found that any particular medicine's date is expired or is near the date of expiry, found not of standard quality, substandard or spurious, supplier's (Appointed Authorized Chemist) firm will be liable to be debarred for a period of 3 years besides other legal action that may be initiated. In case the supplier fails to supply indented drugs/medicines, the FRI will be entitled to procure the same from other chemist and the supplier will be liable to reimburse in full the price paid by the FRI. However the chemist will be allowed to claim what would be payable to him for the medicines as per the agreed terms & conditions.
- (b) In case of indent for specific brand of medicines the same shall not be substituted. If any such case is noticed during subsequent scrutiny after or before the payment, then supplier will be penalized for Rs. 1000 + cost of the specific brand of medicines for each such default.
- 13.5 Indented medicines for the beneficiaries shall be supplied in individual packets by the designated chemist.

13. INDEMNITY

The bidder shall indemnify the FRI against all actions, suits, claims and demands brought or made against it in respect of anything done or committed to be done by the bidder in execution of or in connection with the work of this contract and against any loss or damage to the FRI in consequence to any action or suit being brought against the bidder for anything done or committed to be done in the execution of this contract. The bidder will abide by the job safety measures prevalent in India and will free the FRI from all demands or responsibilities arising from accidents or loss of life, the cause of which is the bidder's negligence. The bidder will pay all indemnities arising from such incidents without any extra cost to FRI and will not hold the FRI responsible or obligated. The FRI may at its discretion and entirely at the cost of the bidder defend such suit, either jointly with the bidder or single in case the latter chooses not to defend the case.

14. PAYMENT

The authorized chemist shall claim payments twice a month. Payments of the bills presented will normally be arranged in 4 to 6 weeks from the date of presentation of the bill. However, the authorized chemist shall make no claim form the FRI in respect of interest or damages in case the payment is delayed for any reasons. The payment has to be through ECS for which bidder should give requisite detail of bank address, Account No. etc.

15. ARBITRATION

The Contract is based on mutual trust and confidence. Both the parties agree to carry out the assignment in good faith.
