

Poster-making competition on "Himalaya Day" organized by FRI EIACP

FRI EIACP (**Environmental Information, Awareness, Capacity Building and Livelihood Programme**) Resource Partner on Forestry and Forest Related Livelihoods serves as a one-stop platform for dissemination of environmental information, informed policy formulation on various facets of the environment, and facilitation of alternate livelihoods through green skilling.
