TREES OUTSIDE FORESTS (TOF) INFORMATION CENTER REPRESENTATIVES

he Center for International Forestry Research and World Agroforestry (CIFOR-ICRAF) is a world-class research institution that delivers actionable evidence and solutions to transform how land and renewable resources are used, and how food is produced. It evolved from the effective merger between CIFOR and ICRAF and has more than 65 years of combined expertise. CIFOR-ICRAF works in partnership with governments, academia, civil society, and private companies to deliver solutions to five major global challenges: deforestation and biodiversity loss, the climate crisis, unsustainable food systems, unsustainable supply and value chains, and extreme inequality.

TOF information center representatives (4 Nos.) with multilingual capabilities are required under the TOF information center facility developed under the Trees Outside Forests in India (TOFI) program. The TOFI program is a joint initiative by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEFCC), Govt of India, implemented by CIFOR-ICRAF.

Role of the representatives: The representative's primary duty involves answering calls routed through the TOF information center in their assigned language from the list mentioned below. Additionally, the representative will be tasked with responding to callers using pre-existing FAQs. If the caller's query is not covered in the FAQs, the representative shall be responsible for forwarding it to the designated expert. Once the expert supplies the answer, the representative will transmit it to the caller using the TOF Information Center System.
